We are pleased to welcoming you to the SECOND EURO MENA DIALOGUE ON PUBLIC MANAGEMENT, to be held in Granada- Spain on 29-31 October 2018

THE EURO MENA DIALOGUE

The Euro-MENA Dialogue is a joint venture between the EGPA, the MENAPAR, Aix-Marseille University, and the Institute of Public Administration of Bahrain (BIPA), aiming to bring together diverse public bodies, scholars and practitioners, research institutions and private corporations to participate and network in view of knowledge exchange, and lesson sharing from practices across and between European and MENA/Arab countries. It also aims to reach a better understanding of the histories

of both regions, in particular in relation to public administration. The dialogue aims to share the different conceptions of Public Administration across the European and Middle East and North Africa regions and to probe the different ideas about PA and PM traditions, approaches, practices and developments. This conference also aims to strengthen cooperation between European and MENA academics and practitioners.

The Euro MENA Dialogues of Public Management are an extrapolation of the Euro-Mediterranean dialogues of Public Management, MED, which were held from 2008 to 2014 under the banner of EGPA and IMPGT (Aix-Marseille University). The Euro MENA is organized every two years. Euro MENA Dialogues address civil servants, practitioners, as well as all experts in public management and researchers coming from social sciences and humanities.

THE EURO MENA DIALOGUE PARTNERS

The 2018 EURO MENA Dialogue is organized by the EGPA, the MENAPAR, Aix-Marseille University and BIPA in close cooperation with the host partners, the Euro-Arab Foundation for Higher Studies and the University of Granada – Faculty of Political Science.

EURO MENA DIALOGUE CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

MENAPAR BEST PRACTICES WORKSHOP

The MENAPAR Best Practices Workshop is held annually as part of the MENAPAR conference and Euro MENA Dialogues. It showcases best practices in Euro and Arab Public Administration and the output from collaboration projects that have been started through the MENAPAR.

This year's best practices workshop that will be held as a prelude to the Euro MENA 2 conference and will continue on the same model as the workshops in Tunisia (MENAPAR2, 2015), Oman (EUROMENA1, 2016) and Ramallah (MENAPAR3, 2017) to include the following:

- Presentation(s) on the output/outcome of collaborations developed on the basis of the first best practices workshop/MENAPAR 2, Euro MENA 1 and IASIA/MENAPAR Conference;
- Use of the UNDP 'knowledge fair' format to organize the event;
- Review of submissions by a committee of experts in public administration to ascertain the proof of concept as a requirement for presentation;
- Development of award mechanisms for "best of the best practices". This is still at the developmental stage and no awards will be distributed this year.
- Dissemination of best practices through the MENAPAR

EURO MENA PhD Workshop

The doctoral workshop for doctoral students, and young researchers in public management is an integral part of the 2nd EUROMENA Dialogue. A variety of contributions are expected in public management and public administration. These highlight the common points and contextual specificities of administration and public management in the countries of the Euro-MENA. The workshop is considered as a time for sharing, exchange, training and learning between researchers, and young scholars aspiring to develop their research work.

EURO MENA Workshops on the Permanent Theme: Governance and Public Administration Paradigms, Conceptions and Approaches in Euro MENA Zone

The participants to the workshops will delve into the diverse paradigms, conceptions and practices of Public Governance and Public Administration in Euro-MENA Zone.

By paradigms, it is meant a coherent pattern of core ideas and premises that govern and explain how things work as well as how things ought to work in a given system - the ideational bases and patterns of thoughts usually presented as an overarching framework to a politico-institutional and administrative system. In Governance and Public Administration, each paradigm can be understood in terms of locus (institutional 'where' of the field, contexts) and of focus ('what' as principles or functioning principles etc.). Public management faces the difficult epistemological and doctrinal foundation of the discipline since the end of the New Public Management, already evoked by the authors of the Oxford Handbook of Public Management (2005). Our conference will participate to answer to this important issue. However, a paradigm is embodied not only in the world of our organizations in discourses; it is revealed in concrete actions and practices of management.

Euro MENA participants will further discuss how paradigms influence and shape the characteristics of public administrative systems and practice. They will identify and investigate the different models rooted in both the Islamic and the European Public Administration and will engage with issues of multiple paradigms spanning across Western (Weberian, Anglo-American) as well as Non-Western Public Administration (Islamic as well as Confucian PA).

In addition to paradigms 'analysis, the participants and paper givers as well as discussants will question different conceptions and practices held for characterising Governance and Public Administration Systems in accordance with Western historical, philosophical and cultural backgrounds.

EURO MENA Workshops on City Management

This second theme of the conference is the changing theme from session to the next.

Cities are key actors in territorial development and key players in steering public reforms.

They are at the forefront of meeting the many current challenges: financial crisis, increasing poverty, climate change, pollution, migration, insecurity, but also a significant need for public services and increasing demands for improving the quality of life ... During the 2nd EUROMENA Dialogue, we will examine the new trends in local territorial management and how cities can respond to these challenges. How to promote the organizational and environmental resilience of cities? What are the sustainable local strategies to promote inclusion of all citizens and meet environmental challenges? What are the alternative forms of governance and new modes of institutional cooperation? What is place of citizens in decisions? What are the new practices of territorial strategic management? How to improve and promote the sustainable attractiveness of cities in the EURO MENA area? What are the operational tools and new practices of territorial officials? These questions will be at the heart of the workshops organized around research and case studies presentations and testimonies during the EUROMENA Dialogue.

These challenges will be underlined and discussed by specialists, such as Anne Girault, Director of the Parisian Agency of Climate which will present the environmental resilience strategy of the City of Paris.

These issues will be discussed during a Round Table on Main Strategies of City attractiveness in the EURO MENA zone and the new approaches of sustainable development in urban environment, organized by the Chair: Attractivity and new territorial marketing of the IMPGT - Aix Marseille University and involving specialists from different countries in the Euro-MENA zone. We look forward to welcoming you in Granada for stimulating discussions on City Management Issues.

Granada also houses a Renaissance cathedral dating from the 16th century and many other architectural monuments of the first magnitude.
